MANY WAYS TO FEEL SOME SPEED

A partly lit network of around 100 kilometres of ski tracks winds its way through the diverse terrain of Himos-Jämsä. Stop by for a coffee break during ski trips at the **Pykälä Hut** and **Countryside Hotel Morva** ski trail cafes. The lit 3.4 km first snow ski trail at Himos starts at the bottom of West Himos.

Several outdoor ice fields and three ice arenas make it possible to play a variety of ice sports. Hundreds of years old, curling is a sport that has maintained its popularity over time. You can book on-ice time at the Längelmäkihalli ice hall for curling. You can skate on the Himos Patalahti Nordic skating track on your own or with a guide (weather permitting).

On snowshoes, you can enjoy the silence of nature and discover its diversity. With the snowshoes still on, you can also check out ski jumping or telemark. On crisp frigid days, McAhon Safarit and Kievari Rantapirtti's dogsled safaris offer an experience that makes your holiday memorable experience!

During sub-zero temperatures you can splash around in the pools at **Uimahalli Koskikara** swimming hall and warm up in the steam room.







Himos Safaris' weekly programme includes a host of things to do, ranging from ice hole swimming adventures to night safaris on a snowmobile. You can rent an ATV or snowmobile and discover Himos' majestic landscapes on your own or join a guided safari. There is also, among other things, a snowmobile school for kids. Himos Safaris services are always tailored to suit each group's needs. Himos is a great place to spend work ability days (TYKY days). Book accommodations, meals and meeting facilities as well as various activities for your group.

At **Simulator World**, you can experience realistic racing in a racing simulator. Get the real feel of a rally Mini Cooper when the

bonnet blows out right before your eyes. Virtual games, gaming consoles, a sports simulator, a shooting simulators and karaoke offer a relaxing change of pace to car racing. Simulator World turns 15 this year, and the newest addition the Rally Simulator flips the car onto its rood and around. Did you know that you can also get a sprint race ride in a real rally car at Simulator World?



RANTAPIRTTI WILL ENCHANT YOU WITH ITS DIVERSITY

Kievari Rantapirtti, located in the magnificent landscapes on the shore of Salosvesi, in the Koskenpää area of Jämsä is a multi-activity centre. It offers not only restaurant services, banquet facilities and accommodation, but also much, much more. Our services include canoeing, snowmobile and ATM safaris, frisbee golf, rally racing, dog sledding, various sauna experiences and ice carting.

"Last winter, we opened an ice carting track for the first time in cooperation with ERM Events, which was a lot of fun. This winter we'll do so again," says Timo Niinimäki, the host of Rantapirtti.

In other words, just staying in accommodation provided by Rantapirtti can be quite the experience.



BOTH SPEED, AND PEACE AND QUIET. The

thrill of speed is not new to Rantapirtti, as it has been involved in rally circle activities since the 1960s. It has worked in cooperation with numerous drivers over the years. Since the 1980s, customers have also had the opportunity to experience what it's like to ride in a rally car. However, the roar of an engine is not always a must.

"Sometimes we go ice-fishing, on skate excursions or kicksledding with guests. We light a campfire and eat, tell stories."

DOG EXCURSIONS. Dog sledding is also a popular winter activity. There are about 30 Siberian huskies at Rantapirtti, all of who have their own unique personalities. Sled rides are always planned according to the customer's needs and wishes to ensure the experience is as unique as possible. "We invest in creating an atmosphere and have received a great deal of praise for this.

GETTING IN TOUCH WITH THE ATMOS- PHERE. Unique experiences are also available for hotel guests. Last summer, Rantapirtti acquired a glamping tent, a phenomena that had risen to great popularity worldwide. This allows for luxury camping and a magnificent landscape. Next summer, the tent will be set up once again on Rantapirtti's lands.

In winter, you can use our other accommodation acquired last summer, AuroraHut, an igloo-boat that floats in a lake.

"It is in use year-round, and the igloo-boat can also be moved to a desired location. In winter, it is lifted onto the ice," explains Niinimäki. In other words, just staying in accommodation provided by Rantapirtti can be quite the experience.



The largest and most diverse ski resort in Southern and Central Finland serves skiers at Himos. The ski season generally starts in mid-December and continues all the way until May Day.

FREESTYLING. At the peak of the winter season, Himos offers 26 lit slopes and 16 lifts to fans of skiing and snowboarding. The slopes come in all levels of difficulty, with something to suit every skill level. Beginners should practice on the easy slopes of HimosLumila. There are several black slopes for experienced skiers and two Snow Parks for those who prefer them. The Snow Park on the northern slopes is expanding and Murrin Streettis on the western slopes serves beginners and more experienced skiers. The resort's ski school provides a safe introduction to downhill skiing for both children and adults, and can even help in refining the technique of even an experienced skier.

A SNOW WORLD FOR THE ENTIRE

FAMILY. HimosLumila offers plenty of fun things to do for the whole day! The area has, among others, two carpet lifts and smooth downhill slopes suitable for skiing, sledding, steerable sleds or snow tubes. For the smallest members of the family, there is also a playground with play equipment, and you can bring along your own food and enjoy a bite at Lumila's three charming lean-tos. The admission fee includes free usage of sleds, steerable sleds, sledding mats and tubes.



GUIDED OR INDEPENDENT ACTIVITIES

The **Children's Traffic Park** has been a summer favourite for kids for decades. In the Traffic Park, children under 140cm in height can learn the rules of the road from behind the wheel of a pedal-powered car.

Himos Safaris organise interesting activities and a wide variety of things to do throughout the year. There are many choices from ATV safaris to archery. At Himos, you can rent an **e-Fatbike**, which will take you on marked routes of just a few kilometres or longer treks. If you so desire, you can take in the gorgeous resort land scapes from the saddle of a bike at the top of Himos, for instance.

At the **Hirvikartano Moose Manor Zoo**, you'll have the chance to meet moose, fallow deer and reindeer up close and personal, maybe even pet them or give them a kiss! The animals are kept in their own natural environment.

Finland's largest Paintball gaming area in Jämsä is used year-round. The end of the summer season at **Jämsä Paintball** culminates with the international Big Game, where there is no shortage of paint ammo. Located close to Himos is the Airsoft range, which is run by **Jämsä Airsoft Games** and features trench networks that bring new challenges to the game.



GOLF AND DISC GOLF

Himos's full-size **golf course** is one of Finland's few resort-style golf courses, which offers accommodation and a wide range of activities in addition to golf. This field is suitable for players of all levels. The six-kilometre course winds its way across an area of 118 hectares, offering outstanding conditions for golf in a beautiful natural setting.

A membership card or green card from any golf club is all that's needed to play on the course. Golfing equipment is available for rent, and there are also courses on offer for a variety of skill levels. DISC GOLF IS FOR EVERYONE. Jämsä also has several free disc golf courses. One of the best things about disc golf is how easy it is to get started. All you need to bring with you is a disc and a get-up-and-go attitude. The 7 courses in the region are generally parklike and easy to navigate. The forested Myllymäki course is suitable for recreational and competitive use.



AN EXERCISE PARK IN THE MIDDLE OF TOWN.


Located in the Jämsä town centre, the **Maauimala activity park** offers a wide variety of sports and recreational activities.

During hot summer days, you can take a swim and spend time on the park sunny terrace and swings sunbathing and enjoying a picnic.



At the Maauimala activity park, visitors can enjoy a game of basketball, beach volley, or pétanque. In the fenced multipurpose arena, you get to play team games such as football and floorball. There is also a new **skate park** in the activity park.

The activity park also has a wide range of outdoor exercise equipment, a children's playground and the world's first **Bukk Off Ice Game Park.** In the Ice Game Park, you can practise stick handling techniques for, among others, ice hockey, rink ball and floorball on a variety of skill courses. For those looking for more fast-paced action, we recommend the **Pumptrack** course for bikes and scooters.



ALONG THE WATERWAYS

Jämsä is located in the middle of the most wonderful part of Lakeland Finland. Enjoy a warm summer day at the beach or try various water activities.

Swimmers and sunbathers alike will love the Maauimala outdoor swimming pool in the town centre and, just a few kilometres away, the beach on Lake Särkijärvi. At Jämsänkoski, the beach of Swimming Hall Koskikara boasts a water slide for kids and a diving platform next to the hall. The shallow and sandy beach at Varpaisniemi makes it a favourite for families with children.

Those holidaying at Himos can relax or try their luck at fishing in **Patalahti's** waters. You can go trolling on the **Jämsänjoki River**, which is located right next to the town centre. At Koskenpää, you can try to lure in a salmon on the swirling waters of **Survosenkoski**

and Virtalanvirta rapids. There are several launches on Pahalampi Pond, one of which is accessible. Lucky Fish and KJM Sportfishing. organise guided fishing trips on Lake Päijänne. Aawee Ammunta & Erä, located near the centre of Jämsä, sells fishing permits and equipment conveniently.

Päijännematkat Koskinen's Tuulikki boats will take you through river country on a cruise to Lake Päijänne. The company's Tuulikki charters depart from the harbour in the centre of Jämsä. Himos Laketours also organises private boat trips along the beautiful Lake Päijänne.

PADDLING ALONG THE WANHA WITONEN


The 75 km long **Wanha Witonen** paddling route runs from Petäjävesi to Koskenpää, through Jämsänkoski and the centre of Jämsä, and then all the way to Lake Päijänne. The route also has shorter sections which are suitable for day trips.


Along the marked route there are small rapids and chutes as well as lakes and river sections. It is also possible to skirt round the rapids by land, making the route suitable for all skill levels. Experienced canoeists can continue on from Päijänne to Arvaja or Himos.

You can enjoy your own meals at the waterside resting areas along the route. In addition to accommodations and restaurants, you can visit various sights along the route, such as the Petäjävesi Old Church, the Aarresaari Local Museum, the Rasuanniemi Nature Reserve and the Pälämäki Local Museum.

Kievari Rantapirtti, Eräopaspalvelu Talvi and Marjakki Oy organise canoe trips, equipment rental, and transport to canoeing locations. Additional information on the services and more precise route details are shown on a waterproof route map, which can be purchased at the City of Jämsä Tourist Information Centre and elsewhere.

COOPERATION. The surveying of the area for maps has been extensive. "This was possible thanks to active sports club members and others who have provided tips on destinations," says Mäkinen, who also enjoys many types of outdoor activities. For example, the Sorvajärvi nature exercise trail made by cycling club CC Ilves will be connected to with the trails.

"Many interesting trails have become familiar. I've travelled some 400 kilometres of them," Mäkinen smiles.

ACCESSIBLE SYNNINLUKKO. With financing from a grant from the Regional State Administrative Agency, the City of Jämsä intends to make the Synninlukko ravine an accessible nature destination. Work is underway to make the edge of the nature conservation are accessible from the parking lot, as well as to construct an outdoor toilet and a scenic platform in accordance with accessibility. The work will be completed during the spring. This means that in the future the magnificent nature destinations in Jämsä will be better accessible to everyone.

NATURE CALLS...

Landscapes shaped by the Ice Age and unique nature reserves await the adventurous.

Isojärvi National Park is an exceptional area for hiking, with over 30 km of marked trails of different lengths. Distributed along the routes there are lean-to shelters and rest areas. The park also includes over 20 islands, which can be explored by canoe or rowboat.

At nearly seven metres in height, Central Finland's largest waterfall **Juveninkoski** is located right along the Partalantie road, near the felt factories. Other good hiking destinations include The **Himos** hiking routes, **Pukinvuori** exercise trail and stairs, **Lake Rotkojärvi in Ruuhivuori**, **Vororotti**, and the **Rasuanniemi natura area**.

Synninlukko is an accessible destination. The Sorvajärvi mountain bike and exercise trail is well marked, and there is a lean-to shelter and campfire site along the route. Enjoy the landscapes of Himosvuori and the diverse terrain also by bike.



JÄMSÄ INVITES VISITORS TO EXPERIENCE NATURE

The paths criss-crossing along the ancient esker area, Rasuanniemi, are one of the many fascinating routes that Jämsä is full of. This, like many other places, is intended to be highlighted even better in the interest of of both residents and tourists. This is being worked on by a tourism project coordinated by the City of Jämsä and funded by the Regional Council of Central Finland, in which the development of routes is part of the whole.

"The aim is to provide versatile, high-quality route alternatives for all types of exercise, hiking, trekking and mountain biking. At the same time, this will also promote tourism and help locals find opportunities to engage in exercise in natural environments more easily, says route specialist Antti Mäkinen.



SAUNA SOOTHES THE SOUL

The country's best smoke saunas and original barrel saunas are from Jämsä. In the Himos-Jämsä area, you can relax and completely escape the workaday world. All of the rental cabins in the area have their own sauna. There are also various great saunas to rent. Several Himos rental cottages have a hot tub or jacuzzi.

IN THE HIMOS HOLIDAY SAUNA COURTYARD, you can go with a large group of people from sauna to sauna, trying outwood-heated, electricity-heated and smoke saunas, or the more exotic barrel sauna. It is pleasant to relax in the heated pools under the twinkling winter stars. The Sauna Courtyard also has large terraces and fireplace lounges as well as a grill shelter for roasting sausages.

The world's first **BARREL SAUNA** can be found in Kievari Rantapirtti at Koskenpää. In the 1950s and 1960s, Rantapirtti's old master

came up with the idea to make a sauna from old tar factory barrels. There is also a hut sauna and a few smoke saunas in Rantapirtti.

A FLOATING SAUNA cruises near Himos, in the Patalahti Bay of Jämsä. The wood stove sauna can accommodate up to 10 people at a time. During the cruise, you can take a swim or grill and enjoy refreshments in between the sauna sessions.

In the **FERRARI SAUNA**, you will hear the best excuses after tough competitions, sweat will flow and the evening will speed along.

Located along the waterfront of Lake Päijänne in Juokslahti, Jämsä, the **SAUNA VILLAGE** offers a genuine sauna experience and a journey into the history of Finnish sauna. Visitors to the Sauna Village can visit the world's most extensive collection of Finnish smoke saunas. Of more than 20 historic saunas in the Village, the oldest dates back to the 1700s and the newest represent smoke sauna construction from the 1940s.



The oldest smoke saunas tell their own story about the history of Finnish saunas, and the traditions of sauna building in different regions. You can also take part in sauna culture at the Sauna Village. In the open saunas on Saturdays in the summer, you can bathe in smoke saunas from all over Finland. You can also book a private sauna.

Grills are available to all visitors and you can come for a picnic whenever you like. The Sauna Village also organises a variety of events and theme days every year. Guided tours presenting the history of the Finnish sauna (in Finnish and English) can be booked in advance. The Sauna Village offers an excellent setting for events or even a recreational day. You can also visit the Village on your own initiative outside sauna sessions.



In January, the **Himos Winter Trail** will be held on beautiful winter trails, and Himos's versatile slope events and After Ski provide fun and excitement for people of all ages.






ART, THEATRE AND ATMOSPHERE

A vibrant cultural life and a diverse range of art leads you to the heart of Jämsä's cultural life.

rotating exhibitions at Galleria Kivipankki all year round. The International felt exhibition is also held at Kivipankki every summer. Taidetila Värinä is a venue for various art courses and exhibitions. Pässinmäki has a permanent art exhibition of the Kauko Sorjonen Foundation collections as well as rotating exhibitions. In the summer, Vinni Cultural Farm holds various cultural events, and the art shed displays works of local artists. Mänttä's famous Serlachius Art Museum is only a 40 minute drive from Jämsä.



GET INSPIRED BY THEATRE. Jämsä has an active amateur theatre scene. Local theatres specialise in comedies and telling stories about the people of Jämsä. **J+J Theatre** is a professionally-led amateur theatre that prepares 3 to 4 new shows every year for adults and children. Jämsä Summer Theatre can be found in Pietilä. Sähkökoski. Kuorevesi Summer Theatre offers comedies for the whole family and has a covered stand for the audience. Teatteri Tenho produces, among others, plays, poetry recitals and humorous programmes. During the winter season, the Turkinkylä Theatre perform funny comedies at the charming Turkinkylä Village Hall. Kinotar Cinema provides the latest, most popular films every day.

DIVE INTO HISTORY. Set out on a journey of discovery to fascinating museums and be

taken away by the trends of yesteryear. Open in the summer, the local museums of Kuorevesi, Längelmäki, Pälämäki and Aarresaari present the history of rural life. The Farmer's Museum contains an extensive collection of farming and forestry machines as well as an exhibition devoted to the work performed by women. Helminauha Toy Museum has an extensive collection of around 10,000 pieces, ranging from the start of the 20th century to the present day. Hallinportti **Aviation Museum** displays the history of aviation in a diverse manner. You can explore small objects, rare aircrafts and library archives. The Veljekset Karhumäki Ltd aerial photography collection presents the founding of Halli and the birth of the Finnish aviation industry in photographs beginning in 1929.

You can also book meeting equipment, catering and activities as supplementary services.

Himosmajoitus offers approximately 60 holiday cottages near the Himos slopes. You can find the right alternative for your needs, whether you're vacationing with a large or small group.

In addition to cottage accommodations, the company also serves holidaymakers at the foot of West Himos at **Restaurant Rinne's** three restaurants. HIMOS IS EXPANDING AND DEVE-LOPING. The city of Jämsä is selling plots of land at Himoslehtelä, located close to the shore opposite the North Himos ski slopes. "We wanted to maintain Jämsä as the topic of the paintings," says **Saara Jalkanen, operative director** of Hotel Jämsä.

Hotel Jämsä's roots stretched back to the 1960s until it was closed in 2018. A new era began in spring 2022 as Margo Saxberg and her spouse Marita Saxberg took over the hotel's ownership. They also provide professional accommodation service in Jyväskylä. The new owner's became interested in expanding to Jämsä when a friend tipped them off about Hotel Jämsä's empty premises, which proved to be in good condition.

SELF-SERVICE. The hotel, which opened in June, operates on a self-service basis. This means that there is usually no personnel present. Instead the room number and key code are sent to the guest's phone. There are 53 rooms and the hotel sleeps a total of 120 guests.

"We provide easy, high-quality accommodation. All services are near-by. There is a service station on the other side of the road that is open around-the-clock, and the town centre isn't far either," says Jalkanen. The hotel's operations have kicked off in a lively manner, and it has been fully booked especially during events such as the Himos festivals and rallies. Business travellers have also found their way to the hotel.

ACTING RESPONSIBLY. Responsibility is an important part of Hotel Jämsä's principles, and this is reflected in recycling, which has been made as easy as possible for customers.

"During renovation work it was clear that any old materials would be saved whenever possible and reasonable, for example some of the furniture is old or recycled, such as fixtures, lighting and art work. Another legendary place in Jämsä, **Restaurant Pikis** opened next to the hotel in the summer. The hotel works in coooperation with Pikis, for example, with regard to meeting facilities. The hotel engages in successful cooperation also with many other actors in Jämsä, as all daily services, such as cleaning, yard care and security, are managed by local companies.

At **Elonen Café**, you can enjoy a buffet lunch along with coffee and a pastry from the award-winning pastry-chefs. Lunch restaurant **Vehnäleipä** and **Witikkala Manor** serve lunch, coffee and delicious pastires. These traditional catering restaurants offer a cosy setting and banquet tables full of delicacies to cater for celebrations of all sizes.

ELONEN CREATES GOODIES IN A RESPONSIBLE MANNER

Cakes, biscuits, baked pulla, breads, pastries and many other delicacies form the core of Elonen's products. Elonen Oy has a long traditions, which date back to 1966, and since then, taste has been of primary importance.

Today, Elonen is the third largest bakery operator in Finland and employs about 250 people. It's home is in Jämsä, but it also operates in eight other localities, with a total of 16 different locations.

NEW TASTES. CEO Jari Elonen explains that product development is particularly important. New products and flavour combinations are constantly being developed.



"We have around 40 to 50 new products each year. We listen to consumer feedback attentively, and we also receive wishes and ideas from consumers, which sometimes end up being implemented after multi-stage testing.

A lot of experimental baking is carried out, which means that samples wind up at the bakery shop in Jämsä. This is also one way of reducing waste.

ENERGY FROM THE SUN. Elonen strives for responsibility in other respects as well. The basic values of the company include high quality and domestic products.

"Corporate responsibility has been important to us for a long time, and this is reflected in such things as the reduction of packaging materials and waste. However, we wanted to do something even more concrete, so in summer 2021 we had solar panels installed for the bakery. At the same time, we encourage others to implement the same solution.

The investment proved to be excellent and well-timed. "We are exceptionally pleased with the solution. Now, around 20% of the bakery's electricity is solar energy.

DAILY GOOD. Jari Elonen has headed the family business from the beginning of the 2000s, but he started work in the bakery long before this in the 1980s.

I've sometimes assisted during the busiest times, but I don't seem to have time for that in addition to my work anymore. It was fun at the time though, I like to bake and cook.

The CEO is also a fan of Elonen's sweet and savoury treats, and he feels that everyone needs a little something tasty every day. His favourites include Helmi cheese cakes and the new product out in autumn 2022 super cinnamon buns.

"There are many taste experiences to be had. We also always have something new to offer."



FELT, DELICACIES AND GEMS

The region of Jämsä is known for its unique felt art and handicraft traditions. This rare (by Nordic standards) concentration of companies, craftspeople and events in the felt industry make up what is nicknamed "Felt Valley of Finland".

The felt factory **Lahtiset** is located in the village of Partala, where it manufactures its nationally renowned long felt boots as well as design products designed by **Aki Choklat** and **Jonas Hakaniemi**. You can also find slippers, bags, felt jewellery, interior decorationproducts and so much more in the factory shop.

The **J. Alho Felt Factory** store has unique slippers, bags, felt jewellery, household goods, "sauna hats" and coolers as well as gift items. The store also has a coffee shop, with homemade baked goods and ice cream.

Handicrafts shop **Mäen Huopaa ja Lankaa** offers felting courses (upon reservation) and

sells products made by Finnish craftspeople, such as jewellery, interior decoration products and other gift items. The store also sells a wide variety of weaving and knitting yarns as well as handicrafts supplies. Finnish woollen yarns from local sheep farms are also sold here.



JÄMSÄ DELICACIES. Elonen's awardwinning bread, cakes and pastries offer great enjoyment both in everyday life and celebrations. The traditional Hirvelä Uunitalkkuna is made from gluten-free oats from the farm's own fields. Produced with the skills acquired over three generations, the fresh berry juices and Christmas casseroles of Ylä-Porkkala Farm are made with the finest local ingredients. The **Uusi-Yijälä Farm** wine shop sells the farm's own berry wines and products from local entrepreneurs. The Jokilaakson Juusto cheese manufacturer produces cheese spreads, pre-grated cheeses and dips as well as vegan delicacies to spread on bread and to use in cooking.

Pajalan Kenkä is a veritable treasure trove of shoes, not to mention clothing, bags and many more accessories. Witikkala Manor's charming 19th century setting houses a café and wonderful lifestyle shop, with a wide variety of branded clothing and interior decoration products. In the town centre, you should visit Vehkala's jeans shop with good service, which also sells other clothes and accessories. Matto & Sisustus Dream Home sells carpets and lovely interior decoration products. There are many things in Taikavakka, including a selfservice second hand shop and a natural cosmetics and gift shop. They also sell high-quality clothes for women and children, made in Finland.
